What: Suspects Identified in Thefts from Autos

LOVELAND, OHIO: On June 22, 2009, in a joint investigation with Miami Township Police Department, Loveland Police identified three suspects (one adult and two juveniles) involved in numerous car break ins in Loveland.

Loveland Police Officers executed a search warrant at a Loveland residence and recovered over two dozen items that had been stolen from unlocked vehicles. These suspects are believed to be responsible for as many as twenty offenses. The case will be presented to the Hamilton County Prosecutor's Office this week for charges.

"This investigation is a great example of cooperation between agencies," said Loveland Police Chief Tim Sabransky. "Sharing information and pooling resources is the key to solving this type of crime."

"Being able to share information and resources gives us all a critical edge in solving these types of crimes," said Miami Township Chief Bailey. "We are glad to have this partnership that benefits both communities."

Even with the identification of these suspects, residents are still reminded to lock car doors and remove or hide any valuable items left in vehicles.
