What: Felonious Assault, Child Endangering Arrest

LOVELAND, OHIO: On June 17, 2009 at approximately 11:30 A.M., Gregory Henderson Jr., 24 of Cincinnati, was arrested by Cincinnati Police at Children's Hospital on an indictment released June 9, 2009 for the following charges: Felonious assault, and two felony counts of Endangering Children.

The indictment is the result of an extensive investigation by Loveland Police Detective Kevin Corbett. In March 2009, Loveland Symmes Fire Department and Loveland Police Officers were dispatched to Park Avenue for an injured four month old child. The child was transported immediately to Bethesda North Hospital and shortly thereafter he was transferred to Children's Hospital with life threatening injuries.

The police investigation began immediately. Detective Corbett worked with Cincinnati Police Personal Crimes, Homicide and Criminalistics Unit Detectives to gather evidence and conduct interviews. "This was a very comprehensive and time consuming investigation that included volumes of medical information" said Loveland Police Chief Tim Sabransky. "It is a tragic situation involving such a young child. We wanted to make sure we had all of the information and evidence possible before presenting the case to the Prosecutor's Office and the Grand Jury."
