**Historic West Loveland Neighborhood:** On Thursday, June 25<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. at Kiwanis Park a meeting will be hosted for the area from Riverside Drive to Main Street to Loveland Madeira Road to the corporate limits along Wall Street.

**Pheasant Hills:** A meeting will be held at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 23 within the Pheasant Hills neighborhood.

**Loveland Heights:** A meeting will be held on Thursday, August 20<sup>th</sup> at the Navaho Tot Lot starting at 7:00 p.m.

**Fox Meadow Farms:** A meeting will be held at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 17 at Lever Park.
