What: Loveland Police Sergeant Graduates Executive Training Program

LOVELAND, OHIO: Loveland Police Sergeant Dennis S. Rahe graduated from the Police Executive Leadership College (PELC) Program on June 19, 2009 with twenty-eight other law enforcement professionals.

The PELC program, sponsored by the Law Enforcement Foundation and the Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police, is a three week course spread out over a three month period that presents contemporary leadership topics to the students. Students wrote six graduate level research papers, made class presentations and worked on a number of group projects. It is an intensive learning experience focused on leadership skills vital to long term personal success and change in the organization which benefit the community.

“PELC was an excellent opportunity to discuss leadership strategies with fellow officers and bring back ideas that I can apply within the Loveland Police Division,” said Sergeant Rahe. Sergeant Rahe, who also holds a Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice, is an eleven year veteran of the Police Division and has been a Sergeant since March 2007.

“Completing this rigorous program is a noteworthy accomplishment for Sergeant Rahe as he continues to be a key member of the Police Division's management team” says Police Chief Tim Sabransky.
