What: City of Loveland Announces 2009 Road Rehabilitation Streets

LOVELAND, OHIO - The City of Loveland is pleased to announce that ongoing efforts to keep our community’s streets and roads at peak performance will continue this summer, beginning July 6. In all, more than 10 percent of Loveland’s roadways will be treated or replaced in 2009.

Vice Mayor Dave Bednar notes the 2009 road rehabilitation program is substantial because of the City’s fiscal conservatism when it comes to budgeting. “The continuation of our road improvement program even in these tough economic times is a testament to the way the City has focused on our core services. While some local governments are struggling to provide even the most basic services, Loveland is fortunate to be able to maintain its service levels even in this recession, all without raising taxes,” Bednar said.

The total budget for Loveland’s road rehabilitation program is \$400,000 and is drawn from income tax, motor vehicle registration and gas taxes. The 2009 contract was awarded to Strawser Construction, Inc., based on a competitive bidding process.

Repairs and treatments will begin with curb repair the week of July 6<sup>th</sup> and continue through the week of July 12<sup>th</sup>; black mat paving commences the week of July 20<sup>th</sup>. All efforts are coordinated so the impact to traffic is minimal and schedules are subject to change due to weather. The following roads are scheduled for repair or resurfacing:

Strawser Construction will provide residents notice that that their street is receiving work the night before they start. Residents will need to make arrangements so their vehicles are not parked on the street or driving on the road until one hour after treatment is completed.
