## **Loveland Opens New Recycling Drop-Off Site**

Recycling in Loveland is now even easier thanks to the opening of a new recycling drop-off on Karl Brown Way, next to Loveland Canoe and Kayak. Residents can drop off recyclables 24-hours a day and do not need to sort their materials, everything can be mixed together.

Loveland still offers curbside recycling, but residents living in apartments or condominiums without access to curbside now have a convenient way to recycle.

The same items that can go into a curbside bin can also go into the recycling drop-off. Recyclables include:

- steel, aluminum and tin cans
- #1 and #2 plastic bottles and jugs
- glass bottles and jars
- office paper
- junk mail
- paperboard (cereal boxes, etc.)
- cardboard
- newspaper
- phone books
- magazines

Pizza boxes, plastic bags or the lids on bottles and jars are not acceptable for recycling. This site **does not** accept tires, batteries or trash.
